IF YOU THINK YOU HAVE A FOODBORNE ILLNESS

Town health directors investigate possible incidents of foodborne illnesses. If you believe you have been made ill from consuming food or beverages from a food service facility, you should report the incident to your town of residence's health department (not to the health department in the town where the food service facility is located).
