PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: The [Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services \(DMHAS\) Housing Subsidy Program](#) is a state-funded rental assistance program for people with a psychiatric disorder which provides for a monthly housing subsidy payment on a temporary basis while the individual/family is on a waiting list for permanent state and/or federal subsidy.

HOW TO APPLY: Be referred by a mental health clinician to local housing Subsidy program; Contact DMHAS Housing Services
