



## Community Based Services for People with Disabilities

The State of Connecticut's Department of Social Services and Department of Developmental Services manage the home and community based services which provides assessment, coordination and payment for services for people who have physical or developmental disabilities and who need supportive services to live independently in the community. The programs can pay for non-medical services such as adult day care, chore assistance, home-delivered meals, companion, homemaker and personal emergency response systems. These services may have income and asset restrictions.
