Money Follows the Person is a federal program for individuals that assists with long-term care needs and allows individuals the freedom to choose where they live and receive services.

Services available under the program consist of:

- Assistance with a move from a nursing home, hospital or qualified institution to a community setting
- Providing community supports and housing options
