



## **Inmate Trust Fund / Inmate Accounts - Connecticut**

The Inmate Trust Fund is managed by the Connecticut Department of Corrections in order to give relatives and friends of inmates a way to give money to an inmate, for use in the prison commissary. It is no longer necessary to be on an inmate's visitor list to send funds to his or her inmate account. The Fund can accept funds by: United States mail, JPAY Electronic Deposit, TouchPay Electronic Deposit or Western Union Electronic Deposit.
