



## Shelter Plus Care

**PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION:** [Connecticut Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services \(DMHAS\)](#)

**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:** [Shelter Plus Care](#) is a HUD-funded program, administered by the Connecticut Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) that provides subsidized rental housing and psychiatric/health case management for persons who are homeless and disabled, and who have a history of psychiatric disability, substance abuse, dual diagnosis, or who are HIV positive. DMHAS subcontracts with community agencies to link eligible people with Shelter Plus Care. **Not all towns in Connecticut are covered by Shelter Plus Care.**

Community providers that administer Shelter Plus Care funds are as follows:

- REGION 1: Shelter Plus Care, 97 Middle Street (Bridgeport)
- REGION 2: New Haven Shelter Plus Care Program (New Haven), River Valley Mobile Services (Middletown), Rushford Center (Meriden)
- REGION 3: United Services (Willimantic), Southeastern Mental Health (Norwich)
- REGION 4: Hartford ACCESS (Hartford), Chrysalis Center (Hartford), Community Mental Health Affiliates (New Britain)
- REGION 5: Greater Danbury Mental Health Center (Danbury), Mental Health Association (Torrington)

**WHO IS ELIGIBLE:** Homeless adults who are HIV positive, or who have a history of psychiatric disability, substance abuse, or a dual diagnosis.

- Contact the community provider agency listed above that serves your community. Referrals must come from a case manager.
